### A Message from

Colin Burns

This Sunday we will have the pleasure of hearing one of my favorite anthems, My

Eyes For Beauty Pine by Herbert

Howells. Howells was an English

composer who lived a tumultuous life.

Born in 1892 as the youngest of six children, he learned to play the organ at his father's knee by age 11. He was able to avoid the small-town shame of his father declaring bankruptcy by moving to Gloucester to study music at the cathedral.

He thrived in his schooling, but a diagnosis of Graves' disease in 1915 threatened to cut his career short. It enabled him to get out of fighting in World War I, and continue composing as he overcame the illness against all odds.

He married in 1920 and lived happily until 1935, when his son, Michael, died of polio. This marked a permanent shift in Howells' life, and everything he wrote from then until his own death in 1983 carried the shadow of that loss.

My Eyes For Beauty Pine was written in 1925, and so does not reflect his grief at the loss of his son, who wouldn't be born for another year. Instead, it

demonstrates his fascination with Tudor music of the 16th century, of composers such as Thomas Tallis and William Byrd.

Music from this time period was very fluid and text-driven, unlike the music of later years that followed a definite beat.

This anthem has a frequently changing meter, to ensure that the words are more important than the notes. It is written for


## Sit & Stitch Meeting


## Music @ St. Alban's

Last week in Chapel we talked about how God created ALL the animals. This week we included people in that story. We learned that God made each of us, our friends, and our


families. How special!
