

EPISCOPAL STUDENT FELLOWSHIP DINNERS

Thank you for volunteering to provide a home-prepared dinner for the members of Davidson College Episcopal Student Fellowship (ESF)! This is one of the primary ways that Saint Alban's supports our ministry to the college students. Following are the particulars for when you are scheduled to provide dinner.

Where: The Sprinkle Room (Room #408) on the 4th floor of the Alvarez College Union building on campus.

When: 5:30 p.m. on Sunday Evenings. Dinner providers are asked to have dinner set up in the Sprinkle Room and ready to be served by 5:20 p.m.

What to Make: Anything that you enjoy making and is easily transportable. Prepare for 15 people (unless informed otherwise) and please provide a vegetarian option. Some form of dessert is always appreciated!

Beverages: Not required. We normally just have pitchers of water, but you may feel free to provide additional beverage options if you would like.

What else do I need to bring: Nothing! Plates, cups, cutlery, napkins, water pitchers, and serving utensils are all provided by ESF.

Arrival and Setting up:

- You should arrive in time to get dinner set up by 5:20.
- Once on campus, drive to the small parking lot on the north side of the College Union building (circled in blue on attached map). You may be able to park here if spaces are available, or you can drop food off and then park in Stowe parking lot down the hill (circled in Red on attached map).
- Enter Union building through the doors just off parking lot.
- There are normally two large carts (one black and one red) under the stairs near the elevator. You may use either one of these to help transport food to the fourth floor.
- Sprinkle Room is in the Northeast corner of the 4th floor.
- Tables and chairs will be set up in the Sprinkle Room and Kevin will leave a black bin with all the serving/dining supplies in there.
- A couple of tables will be set up along the wall for buffet-style serving.

If you have any problems or questions before and on the day you're scheduled, you should contact Elaine Carmann (308-379-2843). If unable to connect with Elaine, you may try Fr. Kevin (401-580-4925), remembering that on the day he is leading worship with the students beginning at 4:30 and may not be able to respond immediately.
